Background

- In November 2006, delegates at the 28th International Data Protection and Privacy Commissioners' Conference in London agreed to share good practice in the fields of communication, regulation and strategy, with the emphasis on a practical approach.
- A Communications Workshop was then hosted by CNIL in February 2007, to exchange practical information, to learn about good communication practice, and to make an inventory of activities and communication tools which have proved to be effective.
- At this workshop, it was agreed that it would be useful to establish an international data protection/privacy communications network, and that the UK would take responsibility for coordinating it.

The purpose of the International Data Protection/Privacy Communicators' Network is to improve the effectiveness of communications by:

- providing a network of contacts for those working on data protection and privacy communications, offering support, information and advice;
- providing a means of benchmarking data protection and privacy communications activities;

and

 providing a group able to carry out specific international projects or liaison on international communications issues, as required by the Commissioners.

Information produced

- A list of all group contacts has been drawn up (attached).
- The group agreed the terms of reference in April (attached).
- A list of relevant international and European meetings has been drawn up, to help group members to identify trigger points for contacting each other (attached).

Good practice shared

Promotional materials have been shared amongst the group, for example:

- Information and materials for APPA Privacy Awareness Week
- The Dadus schools project in Portugal
- DVD from Madrid on the European Data Protection Best Practices prize
- Information on the Czech Republic educational program on protecting personal data
- Research on young people and privacy, from Sweden

Materials adapted

The sharing of materials has resulted in some materials being adapted for use by other countries, for example:

- "The Lights are on" training DVD from the UK was adapted for use by the Basque data protection authority.
- The UK's web pages for young people were adapted for use by the Victorian Privacy Commissioner.

News shared

When significant issues arise or news stories hit the media, the group is beginning to share information with other relevant group members. This has included:

- A consultation paper on a draft Voluntary Information Security Breach Notification Guide from Australia.
- A news item from New Zealand on changes to the UK banking code affecting data security.
- Statement on the UK HMRC disk loss containing records of 25 million child benefit recipients.

Next steps

- There is an opportunity to liaise more closely on events for the European Data Protection Day, and to learn from the APPA Privacy Awareness Week.
- Members are encouraged to check the calendar of international events and to send relevant presentations etc to others in the group.
- We are investigating an online web-based network to make sharing information and contacting each other easier.
